Milwaukee County Research Park



For businesses expanding the boundaries of imagination and applying the technology of tomorrow, the **Milwaukee County Research Park** provides the environment, the resources, the support, and the inspiration to break new ground.

Location

The **Milwaukee County Research Park** is located in Wauwatosa, the geographic center of metropolitan Milwaukee and all of Southeastern Wisconsin. Just ten minutes from downtown Milwaukee, the site is convenient to two major expressways, Interstate I-94 and U.S. Highway 45. Within the 175-acre Park, available building sites range in size from one to 20 acres.

Cooperation

The **Milwaukee County Research Park** partners with four major universities: Marquette University, Medical College of Wisconsin, University of Wisconsin-Milwaukee, and the Milwaukee School of Engineering. Tenants have access to these universities and their faculties, students, laboratories, libraries and specialized equipment.

Technology and Innovation

The Technology Innovation Center (TIC) is a self-supporting 137,000-sq. ft. high-technology business incubator located at the **Milwaukee County Research Park**. Since opening its doors in March 1993, the TIC has attracted over 70 firms, and the 40 who now occupy it make the TIC one of the largest incubators in the US. The majority of TIC companies are involved in information technology and bio-medical technology. The TIC has six laboratories, conference rooms, high-bandwidth Internet access, a library, monthly business seminars and a host of other business resources.
