

County Executive Scott Walker's Resolutions for 2005

1. Continue to reform government through updates to the ethics rules and improvements to the contract selection process.
2. Increase the number of partnerships with the private sector in our park system and at the county zoo.
3. Aggressively move forward on the development of the Park East Corridor land (ideally without County Board imposed limitations).
4. Advance the controlled development of the Northeast Quadrant on the county grounds through a partnership with the City of Wauwatosa.
5. Push for employee contracts that pull back on the pension and sick leave benefits granted in 2000.
6. Promote Milwaukee County as an excellent place to visit throughout our annual Harley ride; visits with convention planners and other projects.
7. Find a way to take down and replace the courthouse Annex parking structure without using property tax levy funds.
8. Help General Mitchell International Airport to grow with improvements on several concourses and security areas.
9. Lobby state government to give the county more flexibility to handle the cuts in Governor Doyle's 2005/2007 state budget.
10. Propose a budget for 2006 that (once again) freezes the property tax levy.
